

Perdana Petroleum, Econpile secure contracts

Perdana Petroleum Bhd's subsidiary Perdana Nautika Sdn Bhd has secured a contract worth RM67 million from Petronas Carigali Sdn Bhd for the supply of a floating accommodation vessel.

In a filing to Bursa Malaysia yesterday, the offshore support service provider noted the charter will run for a period of three years starting Sept 17, 2016, with an option to extend up to two years.

Meanwhile, Econpile Holdings Bhd's wholly owned subsidiary, Econpile (M) Sdn Bhd has received a contract worth RM280 million from ASM Development (KL) Sdn Bhd to undertake earthworks, piling works and basement structure works of a mixed development.

The foundation works are for a project that will comprise seven blocks of serviced apartments, retail and car park at Lot 36190, Mukim Petaling, Kuala Lumpur, the construction concern noted in an exchange filing yesterday.
