

PERDANA PETROLEUM BAGS CONTRACT TO CHARTER WORK BARGE TO KEYFIELD SERENITY

KUALA LUMPUR (July 30): Perdana Petroleum Bhd's (KL:PERDANA) subsidiary, Perdana Nautika Sdn Bhd, has secured a charter contract to provide a work barge to Keyfield Serenity Sdn Bhd.

In this deal, Perdana Nautika is to provide Keyfield with a work barge marine vessel, along with the crew and equipment needed for 24-hour assistance, accommodation, or transport for offshore operations.

The contract is expected to last over a period of 241 days, ending around March 7, 2027, and is expected to contribute to the company's revenue in its 2026 and 2027 financial years.

Keyfield is a local company that charters marine vessels, either their own or from other companies, primarily for offshore accommodations. They are a panel contractor to Petronas Carigali Sdn Bhd.

In its bourse filing on Thursday, Perdana Petroleum said that the contract was originally secured back on May 21 and commenced on July 9.

Perdana Petroleum's shares closed half a sen or 3.03% lower to 16 sen per share on Thursday, valuing the company at RM356.5 million.
